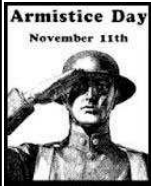

DG Ken and wife Lion Marie provided support for our car raffle sales at Apple Scrapple this year. Senator Carper also passed by our table.



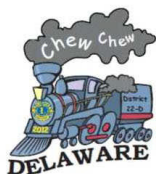
